- I. Know your tendency to question the sufferer (1-16).**
 - A. Man tends to make false accusations to the sufferer (1-6).**
 1. Eliphaz accuses Job by his questions (1-3).
 2. Eliphaz accuses Job of challenging God (4).
 3. Eliphaz accuses Job of sinning with his mouth (5).
 4. Eliphaz accuses Job of incriminating himself (6).
 - B. Man tends to make false assumptions to the sufferer (7-16).**
 1. Eliphaz insults Job (7-9).
 2. Eliphaz makes false assumptions of himself (10).
 3. Eliphaz makes false assumptions of Job (11-16).
- II. Know your tendency to express your opinions to the sufferer (17-35).**
 - A. Man tends to express opinions based on experiences (17-20).**
 1. Eliphaz gives opinions based on his own experiences (17).
 2. Eliphaz gives opinions based on the experiences of the aged (18-20).
 - B. Man tends to express opinions based on false assumptions (21-35).**
 1. Eliphaz gives his opinions on the fate of the wicked (21-24).
 2. Eliphaz gives his reasons for the fate of the wicked (25-29).
 3. Eliphaz gives his opinions on the future of the wicked (30-35).
