# A. God's love demands a choice (15).

- 2. The blessing of eternal life (15).

# II. Appreciate the vastness of God's love (16).

#### A. God loves the world (16a).

- 1. The magnificence of God's love (16a).
- 2. The magnitude of God's love (16a).

# B. God exemplifies his love for the world (16b).

- 1. He gave the world His only Son (16b).
- 2. He gives the world a choice (16c).

# III. Appreciate the validity of God's love (17).

# A. God validates the purpose of His love negatively (17a).

- 1. God's purpose for sending His Son was not condemnation (17a).
- 2. God's purpose for sending His Son was not political (17a).

# B. God validates the purpose of His love positively (17b).

- 1. God' purpose for sending His Son was the salvation of the world (17b).
- 2. God's purpose for sending His Son was the salvation of Israel (17b, Matthew 1:21)
