

The Truth About Christ's Position John 3:22-30

I. Sacrifice your position. (22-26).

A. Remain faithful (22-24).

- 1. Christ's disciples baptizes new believers (22).
- 2. John continues baptizing faithfully (23).
- 3. John remains faithful until his death (24).

B. Remain unconcerned by results (25-26).

- 1. John's disciples are involved in a dispute (25).
- 2. John's disciples display jealousy (26).
- 3. John's disciples display discouragement (26b).

II. Surrender your position (27-30).

A. Realize your position (27-28).

- 1. John realizes his position (27a).
- 2. John realizes God's character (27b).
- 3. John reminds his disciples of his position (28).

B. Realize Christ's position (29-30).

- 1. John expresses his relationship with Christ (29a).
- 2. John expresses his delight in Christ (29b).
- 3. John expresses his joy in Christ's exaltation (29c).
- 4. John expresses his desire of Christ's exaltation in his life (30).



Man's Tendency to Speak Wrongly in Times of Trouble Job 20:1-29

- I. Know your tendency to speak irrationally (1-3).
 - A. Man tends to speak according to his own thoughts (1-2).
 - B. Man tends to speak out of anger (3).
- II. Know your tendency to speak incorrectly (4-22).
 - A. Man tends to make false assumption (4-11).
 - B. Man tends to make false applications (12-22).
- III. Know your tendency to speak insensitively (23-29).
 - A. Man tends to speak harshly (23-26).
 - B. Man tends to speak without understanding (27-29).
