- I. Know your time of satisfaction (1-9).**
 - A. Christ is sovereign (1-6).**
 - 1. Christ knows man's heart (1-2).
 - 2. Christ knows the best way (3-6a).
 - 3. Christ knows the best time (6b).
 - B. Christ is sensitive to others' needs (7-9).**
 - 1. Christ intentionally meets the Samaritan woman (7-9).
 - 2. Christ intentionally converses with the Samaritan woman (7-9).
- II. Know your of satisfaction (10-14).**
 - A. Man needs to know to the gift of God (10).**
 - 1. Christ wants the woman to know God's gift (10a).
 - 2. Christ wants the woman to ask for God's gift (10b).
 - B. Man needs to respond to the gift of God (11-14).**
 - 1. The woman desires to know how to receive God's gift (11-12).
 - 2. Christ explains to the woman how to receive God's gift (10a, 12-13).
 - 3. Christ explains the blessings of God's gift (12-13).
- III. Know your thirst of satisfaction (15-19).**
 - A. Man desires lasting satisfaction (15).**
 - 1. The woman misunderstands God's gift (15a).
 - 2. The woman desires God's gift for convenience (15b).
 - B. Man must see his need of lasting satisfaction (16-19).**
 - 1. Christ exposes the woman's sin (16-18).
 - 2. Christ exposes the woman's need of salvation (16-18).
 - 3. Christ displays His omniscience (19).



Sorry! I Just Assumed
Job 22:1-30

- I. Man assumes certain truths about God (1-5).**
 - A. Man assumes that God is unconcerned with human behavior (1-3).**
 - B. Man assumes that God only judges the guilty (4-5).**
- II. Man assumes certain truths about others (6-20).**
 - A. Man assumes one has sinned (6-9).**
 - B. Man assumes the consequences of one's sin (10-20).**
- III. Man assumes certain truths about suffering (21-30).**
 - A. Man assumes that man must repent when suffering (21-27)**
 - B. Man assumes that circumstances will improve when one repents (28-30).**
