

The Truth about Disingenuous Faith John 5:1-16

I. Disingenuous faith displays a lack of genuine faith (1-9).

A. Man displays certain faith (1-4).

- 1. The sick displays faith by waiting at the pool (1-4)
- 2. The sick displayes faith by getting into the pool (1-4).

B. Man decides the object of his faith (5-9).

- 1. The impotent man displays faith in the pool (5-7).
- 2. The impotent man displays faith in Christ (8-9).

II. Disingenuous faith displays a lack of genuine fruit (10-16).

A. Pressure reveals the genuineness of fruit (10-13,15).

- 1. The impotent man receives pressure from the Jews (10).
- 2. The impotent man puts the blame on Christ (11-13, 15).

B. Response to truth reveals the genuineness of fruit (14-16).

- 1. Jesus Christ gives the impotent man truth (14).
- 2. The impotent responds to truth negatively (15).
- 3. The Jews responds to truth negatively (16).



Man's Understanding of the Wicked Job 27:1-23

- I. Man's understanding of the wicked displays a defensive spirit (1-6).
- A. Man defends himself from past wickedness (1-4).
- B. Man defends himself from future wickedness (5-6).
- II. Man's understanding of the wicked displays a decisive spirit (7-10).
- A. Man expresses decisive thoughts of his enemies (7).
- B. Man expresses decisive thoughts of the future of his enemies (8-10).
- III. Man's understanding of the wicked displays a definitive spirit (11-23).
- A. Man gives a definitive instruction of the wicked (11-12).
- B. Man gives a definitive description of the future of the wicked (13-23).
