**John 4:43-54**

- I. Observe the signs of a pseudo-faith (43-46a).**
  - A. Pseudo-faith displays a lack of honor (43-44).**
    - 1. Christ delays His arrival at Galilee (43).
    - 2. Christ details His lack of respect (44).
  - B. Pseudo-faith displays a fallacious reception (45-46a).**
    - 1. The Galileans receive Christ based on popularity (45).
    - 2. The Galileans receive Christ based on pressure (46a).
- II. Observe the signs of a saving faith (46b-54).**
  - A. Genuine desperation precedes saving faith (46b-49).**
    - 1. The nobleman's son is gravely ill (46b).
    - 2. The nobleman travels a long distance (47a).
    - 3. The nobleman pleads with Christ to heal his son (47b).
    - 4. The nobleman's lack of faith is exposed (48).
    - 5. The nobleman remains persistent (49).
  - B. Genuine belief results into saving faith (50-54).**
    - 1. The nobleman demonstrates genuine faith (50).
    - 2. The nobleman's genuine faith is confirmed (51-53a).
    - 3. The nobleman's household displays genuine faith (53b).
    - 4. Christ displays His second miracle in Galilee (54).



*God is in Control*  
**Job 26:1-14**

- I. Man displays confusion (1-4).**
  - A. Man is weak (1-2).**
    - 1. Job implies Bildad's weakness (1-2).
    - 2. Job implies his own weakness (1-2).
  - B. Man lacks wisdom (3-4).**
    - 1. Job implies Bildad's lack of wisdom (3-4).
    - 2. Job implies his own lack of wisdom (3b).
- II. God displays control (5-14).**
  - A. God displays control outside the earth (5-10).**
    - 1. God controls the depth of the earth (5).
    - 2. God controls death (6).
    - 3. God controls the space (7).
    - 4. God controls the skies (8-10).
  - B. God displays control in the earth (11-14).**
    - 1. God controls the weather (11-12).
    - 2. God controls the heaven and sea (13).
    - 3. God's control is incomprehensible (14).
